

Bank Wires

Bank wires may be authorized from your account to another financial institution.

- Contact the receiving institution for specific wire transfer instructions, including their complete name, address and 9-digit ABA number. Find out if the bank uses an intermediary bank to route the wire through before it reaches its final crediting institution. Many small credit unions and banks use an intermediary institution. You will also need the account name and number at the receiving institution to which the funds will be credited.
- International Wires will need country and city information or swift code.
- If you are wiring the money to your own account at another institution, you can give us wire instructions over the telephone.
- If you are wiring the money to someone else's account, we must have the information in writing with your signature.
- Bank Wire requests must be received by 2:30 PM (CST) for same day processing.
- Domestic Bank Wires will take 24 to 48 hours to receive. International Bank Wires may take as long as a week to receive.
- Wires in the amount of \$2,500 or more will require a call back.
- Fees: Domestic – \$15.00 per wire. International – \$50.00 per wire. Incoming Wire – \$5.00 per wire.

- International Wire Transfer Form (available at GoAFFCU.com)
- Complete and print the appropriate form. Fax the completed, signed form to 210.678.5294.
- International wires will need to have address, city, state and country of the receiving party.
